## WHAT IS A FREEDOM PASS?

The freedom pass for older people gives free travel on most public transport in London after 9.00am weekdays (9.30am on most National Rail services within the London region), and all day at weekends and public holidays.

See leaflet LBS 07 Revised Feb 2006 for further details, which will be given to you with your pass.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Men and women aged 60 and over permanently living in a London borough.

## WHERE DO I APPLY?

### YOU MUST APPLY IN PERSON.

If you live in one of the boroughs listed below you must apply at a Post Office<sup>®</sup> branch located in any of these boroughs:

Barnet, Bexley, Brent, Camden, Croydon, Ealing, Enfield, Greenwich, Hackney, Hammersmith & Fulham, Haringey, Harrow, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Islington, Kensington & Chelsea, Kingston upon Thames, Lambeth, Lewisham, Merton, Newham, Redbridge, Richmond upon Thames, Southwark, Sutton, Tower Hamlets, Waltham Forest, Westminster, Corporation of London.

If you live in one of the boroughs listed below you must contact your local council for information about their local issuing arrangements. Please note that Post Office<sup>®</sup> branches located in the boroughs below do not issue freedom passes.

Barking & Dagenham, Bromley, Havering, Wandsworth.

## WHEN YOU APPLY

You must bring one item from each of the sections 1, 2 and 3 below.

If you are renewing your pass you MUST bring your current pass and photocard as this will be revalidated and returned to you.

### PROOF OF NAME AND AGE AND ADDRESS

#### 1 You must provide ONE example from the list below as proof of name and age:

Tick the relevant box

- Freedom Pass (exp Mar 06 with Photocard) – ALL RENEWALS
- Letter of Pension Entitlement
- Current Passport
- Medical Card
- Birth Certificate (unless your name has changed)
- Pink Driving Licence (Paper or Photocard)

#### 2 You must also provide ONE example from the list below as proof of address:

Tick the relevant box

- Current Council Tax Bill/Letter/Payment Book
- Current Council/Housing Association Rent Book/Statement/Letter
- Current Television License

The items below must be dated in the last 3 months

- Residential Utility Bill
- Residential Bank/Building Society Statement
- Inland Revenue Letter
- Benefits Agency Letter
- Letter of Pension Entitlement or Occupational Pension Letter
- Residential Credit Card Statement

#### 3 PHOTOGRAPHS – You must also provide:

Tick the relevant box

- Existing Freedom Pass Photocard (If you are renewing your pass) or
- 2 recent passport size photos of yourself (if this is your first application or you do not have a photocard because it has been lost or stolen)

## REPLACING LOST, STOLEN OR FAULTY PASSES

Lost or stolen passes can be replaced at the place of issue\*. You may be asked to attend an interview to explain the circumstances surrounding the loss.

Damaged passes can be replaced at the place of issue\*.

You are only allowed to hold one freedom pass at any one time.

ONLY USE THE MOST RECENTLY OBTAINED PASS AND RETURN ANY OTHERS.

If you find a pass you have previously lost please send it to the following address:

Once your old pass has been replaced, it will no longer work.
